The project addresses the skills and services necessary to the digital industry of the future and will develop an international network of interconnected labs which will offer flexible options for digital study to Master and PhD students but also a viable platform of collaboration with companies in the area of industry 4.0.

Through its research infrastructure and human resource opportunities, the project will launch a collaborative platform that can truly enhance the industry 4.0 array of possibilities.

On the 8th of February, UPB received the visit of the EELISA management team (European Alliance for Engineering, Education, Innovation and Science), led by President Dale A. Martin.

They spoke to our community about the next steps we will take together in the alliance, as well as the challenges we will face together and the solutions to these challenges. We also had the opportunity to discuss the many ways in which this initiative will reshape the future of engineering in the context of European industry.
