November 10, 2022, was an important date for EELISA: it was the commemoration of Elisa Leonida Zamfirescu's birthday, the woman who inspires the acronym of the Alliance, and the World Science Day for Peace and Development. It was also the day EELISA launched the EELISA Days.

From 10 to 17 of November, EELISA university campuses are going to hold different workshops, hackathons, exhibitions, and digital contests focused on various themes, such as renewable energy, digitalisation, sustainability, artificial intelligence, and many other topics of interest.

Also, UPB organized the event "Exploring endless opportunities with EELISA Communities" as part of "EELISA DAYS".

Between 9 and 11 November, UPB attended the 2022 Annual Conference of the Danube Rectors' Conference.

Professor Daniel Crunțeanu, Dean of the Faculty of Aerospace Engineering, represented our community at the 2022 DRC Annual Meeting, which took place at the University of Maribor, Slovenia.

The event included talks about the Green Deal, Resilience, Digital Transformation and topics of great interest in the current development of the Danube Region.





Continuing the event series "Taste the culture of the world – a culinary experience". On November 17, UPB provided another great opportunity for international students to present the culinary specialties of their home countries and make new friends.

15 students representing teams from 10 countries were selected to participate in the event, following the application period.

The students were excited to prepare their national dishes for the competition and were judged by the audience.

UPB became a founding member of the Francophone Research Network on Artificial Intelligence (ReFIA) of the AUF, during the first General Assembly which took place during the World Week of Scientific Francophonie in Cairo, from November 25 to 28.

ReFIA aims to strengthen French-speaking excellence by developing a collective scientific dynamic around AI in the French-speaking world.





Between November 24 – 28, UPB attended the International Education Fairs Morocco 2022.

UPB participates alongside other Romanian universities in student educational fairs and other related activities in Casablanca, El Jadida, and Marrakesh.

The event was organized with the support of the Romanian National Council of Rectors.

On November 28, the International Mobility Day event took place at UPB, dedicated to the students of our university.

UPB invited the representatives of the most important Frenchspeaking institutions to present to our students the mobility programs, the advantages of mobility abroad, and also, the opportunities to acquire valuable professional, linguistic and personal experiences.





The EELISA - European University Governing Board and the EELISA Student Council met in Paris between 14-15 November 2022 to consolidate the strategic decisions for next year. The events were hosted by Université Paris Sciences et Lettres and École des Ponts ParisTech.

The Governing Board has consolidated the strategy followed by the EELISA for the next period of Erasmus+ funding 2023-2027. The Student Council debated key issues, such as the enlargement of the Alliance, student mobility interdisciplinarity among faculties beyond engineering.

UPB was successfully represented by Professor Florin Nemţanu, Vice-Dean of the Faculty of Transports, and Professor Cristian Pîrvu, Vice-Dean of the Faculty of Chemical Engineering and Biotechnologies, at the "a2 International Education Fairs -Azerbaijan" held in Baku, between December 2-4.

The Education Fair was an opportunity for prospective students to speak directly with the representatives of higher education institutions and gather information on the large variety of academic programs.

The Education Fair is part of the Worldwide higher education event series organized yearly with the support of the Romanian National Council of Rectors.

- Practice writing and speaking and get an introduction to Portuguese and Brazilian culture;
- Get an insight of the events organized in Romania by the Portuguese speaking community.

The Preparatory Year – Romanian Language Course is mandatory for those students who wish to pursue their studies in Romanian language and do not have a valid language certificate. During this one-year, full-time academic program, the international students will acquire the necessary skills in reading, writing, listening and speaking in Romanian for academic purposes, but also specific knowledge correlated with future training profile.

Registration period: February 1, 2023 - August 1, 2023

The curriculum for the preparatory year implies studying the following mandatory subjects over two semesters.

First semester:

- Romanian language, levels A1-A2;
- Romanian culture and civilization.

Second semester:

• Romanian language, level B1 (introduction to specialized language)

- exam 2 or 3 credits (ECTS) are granted, depending on the host university


